Our St. Patrick's Day celebration on March 14<sup>th</sup> is in need of a coordinator. John Rooney of Fond Memories will provide music for the event. Residents will bring side dishes. Elizabeth Woods and Bob Baines may co-host this event.

Christmas Party 2019: Attendance was down from last year. Attendees relayed the following feedback. Bill Reid's email comments (attached to Dec minutes) were also included in the discussion. Discussion took place whether we should do the following: 1)continue to have another Christmas Party in the evening and Caroling, 2)have a Christmas Luncheon and Caroling; and 3)to have a Brunch and Caroling. Caroling was successful in 2019 and will be held again this year. A vote took place by the Social Committee members presently to have a Christmas Luncheon and Caroling for 2020 (9 in favor and 1 opposed). Elizabeth Woods and Mary Lu Babcock volunteered to do the initial exploratory work for a venue.
